7:00 p.m. *The Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper*

As we begin tonight's solemn liturgy, Lent quietly ends. We enter into the Easter triduum and welcome the Passover of the Lord with the Liturgy of the Word, washing of feet, the Eucharist. The holy oils blest at the Chrism Mass will be presented at the beginning of this Mass. The Mass concludes with the procession, quiet adoration, and prayer.

Good Friday + April 19th.

NO Mass today. The church is open all day for your private prayers. It is a day of fast & abstinence.

7:00 p.m. *Liturgy of the Lord's Passion and Death*

We prostrate ourselves in silence. We listen to St. John's account of the Passion and make intercession for the whole world. We venerate the wood of the Cross and partake of Holy Communion reserved from last evening's Mass of the Lord's Supper. A special collection is taken up for the care of the Holy Land Shrines.

Holy Saturday + April 20th.

NO 4:00 p.m. Mass today at Blessed Sacrament.

8:00 p.m. *The Solemn Celebration of the Easter Vigil*

We gather outside (weather permitting) for the lighting of the new fire and the blessing of the Easter Candle. We listen to the age-old stories of our faith, sing the first Alleluia of Easter, renew our baptismal promises and receive the Eucharistic Lord in Communion.

Easter Sunday Morning + Solemn Mass of Easter + April 21st.

8:00 a.m. We celebrate the joy of Easter, renew baptismal promises, and receive the water of life.
